Internal Medicine Physician (Multiple Openings) in Yakima, WA

DUTIES:

Responsible for providing high quality and cost-effective medical management of patients, including services in palliative care. Diagnose and provide non-surgical treatment for diseases and injuries for patients 16 years of age and older. Provide internal medicine and/or critical care services to patients, palliative care (treatment of pain and symptoms) to those patients with malignancies or terminal illnesses. Diagnose and treat a wide range of problems associated with the internal organs, such as the stomach, kidneys, liver, and digestive tract. Utilize a variety of diagnostic techniques to treat patients through medication or hospitalization and refer patients to specialists when more complex care is required. Provide appropriate communication to specialists in order to ensure continuity of care.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- An M.D. or D.O. degree, or the foreign equivalent.
- Completion of an accredited US residency program in Internal Medicine.
- Completion of a US fellowship program in Palliative Care.
- Washington State Physician and Surgeon License or a Washington State Osteopathic Physician and Surgeon License, or eligibility for licensure.

All education, training, and experience may be gained concurrently. Applicants subject to pre-employment background check. Applicants must be U.S. workers (includes U.S. citizens, permanent residents, foreign nationals granted temporary residence under one of the 1986 legalization programs, refugees, and asylees).
